Candidates successfully passing the academy and processing may become Reserve I Deputy Sheriffs, who are supervised by a fully certified Orange County Deputy Sheriff. They donate at least 20 hours of service per month and attend one monthly meeting.

- Must be at least 19 years old
- Have a valid Florida Driver's License
- Complete Physical, Drug Screening, 7-year Driving Record, and Criminal Background Check
- Complete and pass assessment evaluation process
