The Orange County Police Athletic League was established in 1991 as an entity of the Orange County Sheriff's Office. P.A.L. has thousands of children participating in its programs throughout Orange County. P.A.L. not only offers sports and recreational activities to youngsters but provides educational programs as well. P.A.L. kids benefit from classes in alcohol, drug and gang resistance, conflict resolution, seat belt and gun safety, and more. The importance of school is greatly emphasized and P.A.L. children have the opportunity to get after-school tutoring, participate in reading and writing programs, and learn computer skills.
